

NGRI-AHI Indian National Hydrology Lecture Award

The National Geophysical Research Institute (CSIR-NGRI) and Association of Hydrologists of India (AHI) jointly invite nominations for the Award of “**NGRI-AHI Indian National Hydrology Lecture Award**” for the year – 2012.

Guidelines for nominations:

1. The Lecture Award will be annually awarded to an eminent national / international hydrologist who has made an outstanding contribution to Hydrology with special focus on India.
2. The contributions should have significant national and international impact.
3. Candidates who have made significant contributions in academic and R & D Lines with a balanced approach to both theoretical and field research will have an added advantage.
4. The nominations can be made by Institutions, Organizations and Reputed Scientists.
5. The Award will carry a cash Prize of Rs.50, 000/- and a brief citation.
6. The Awardee will be requested to deliver a Lecture at a scientific meeting organized by CSIR-NGRI / AHI in India.
7. Wherever necessary the Award winner will be provided travel expenses and local hospitality limiting such expenditure up to a maximum of Rs. 20,000/-.
8. The nominations containing the details of academic profile, research publications, awards and honours, significant contributions, communications details of nominee supported by pertinent documents as attachment may be mailed on or before 31st January, 2013.
